DAY 1 – THURSDAY, JUNE 16TH

6:30 a.m. – Arrive at LHS – Please be sure to bring a disposable sack lunch and drink.
7:00 a.m. – Board Imperial Travel motor coaches; sit back, relax, and enjoy the drive to Ohio!
11:30 a.m. – Arrive Go Ape Adventure Park in Strongsville, OH. Eat sack lunch and get ready to begin treetop and axe throwing adventures at noon.
12:00 p.m. – Go Ape Treetop Discovery tour and axe throwing in pre-assigned groups.
3:00 p.m. – Leave Go Ape Adventure Park (hopefully with no broken or missing limbs!); travel to Pittsburgh.
5:15 p.m. – Arrive at Pomodoro Pizza for group pizza buffet.
6:00 p.m. – Board buses; travel to (nearby) hotel
6:10 p.m. – Arrive at **Hampton Inn Wexford/Sewickley**. Upon arrival, room keys will be distributed to the chaperones. Change (quickly) into formal concert outfit.

8:30 p.m. – Following the concert and fellowship with those in attendance; board buses to return to hotel; upon return, relax and enjoy some free time at the hotel (no specific uniform)

6:00-6:45 a.m. – Breakfast at hotel – you may eat at any time during these assigned breakfast hours

6:45-7:00 a.m. – Turn in room keys to Susan in lobby; load luggage onto buses

7:00 a.m. – Depart for **Washington DC**

8:45 a.m. – Arrive at Flight 93 National Memorial in Shanksville, PA. Upon entering the memorial, we will stop at the Flight 93 Tower of Voices.

9:00-9:40 a.m. – Explore the Flight 93 Visitors Center in chaperone groups.

9:40 a.m. – Board buses for short ride to Memorial Plaza.

9:50 a.m. – **LCC informal short performance at Flight 93 Memorial Plaza**

10:00 a.m. – Board buses; continue to Washington DC

11:45 a.m. – Lunch stop in chaperone groups Hagerstown, MD. Options include Wendy's, McDonald's & Burger King

12:30 p.m. – Board buses; continue to Washington DC

1:45 p.m. – Arrive at **Arlington National Cemetery**. Upon arrival, we will meet our MCI tour manager.

2:00 p.m. – Embark on a guided open-air tram tour of Arlington National Cemetery.

2:30 p.m. – Observe the **Changing of the Guard** at the **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier**. Following the ceremony, LCC will present an informal concert at the **Memorial Amphitheatre**.

4:00 p.m. – Tour ends; board buses; travel to Washington DC city center

4:30 p.m. – Arrive at **Washington Marriott at Metro Center**; check into rooms, refresh and relax

6:25 p.m. – Reconvene in hotel lobby; walk as a group to Carmine's Italian Restaurant

6:45 p.m. – **Group welcome dinner at Carmine's Italian Restaurant** to celebrate our arrival in Washington DC! Following dinner, walk back to the hotel in chaperone group, taking time to enjoy Washington DC by night – or hurry back to the hotel and enjoy the pool!

10:00 p.m. – All choir members need to be in their assigned rooms.

10:30 p.m. – Lights out!

DAY 3 – SATURDAY, JUNE 18TH

White House Tour – Smithsonian Museums – Nationals Baseball Game

Uniform: LCC Washington DC Tour T shirt (red), blue jeans or blue jean capris/shorts, white tennis shoes

Hotel: Washington Marriott at Metro Center

7:00-8:00 a.m. – Private breakfast buffet at hotel in the Salon 1 conference room located on the second floor – you may eat at any time during these assigned breakfast hours

8:30 a.m. – Gather in hotel lobby; board buses. **Adults need to be sure to have their government issued photo ID with them.** The White House does not allow liquids or bags of ANY type, so all bags, purses, fanny packs, backpacks, water bottles, etc. must be left on the buses when they drop us off. (We will return to the buses after the tour to retrieve our bags.) LCC or MCI neck wallets, billfolds, and cell phones ARE allowed, but there is to be no video or flash photography during the tour.

8:45 a.m. – Arrive at the White House; pass through security in pre-assigned groups

9:30 a.m. – Embark on a **self-guided tour of the White House**. (Groups 1 & 2 will tour the White House at the same time, so the group assignments were only needed for security purposes.)

10:30 a.m. – Tour concludes. We will meet our buses and collect our bags and belongings. At this point, all tour participants have free time to visit the monuments, memorials, and **Smithsonian Museums** along the **National Mall** in chaperone groups. There are a variety of options for lunch along the National Mall, so please plan to eat lunch in chaperone groups before our next departure time.

3:30 p.m. – Meet outside the **Natural History Museum** (900 block Madison Drive NW) and board our buses; depart for Nationals Park

4:35 p.m. – Play ball! We'll watch the **Washington Nationals** play the Philadelphia Phillies at **Nationals Park**! Your ticket also serves as your **\$15 dinner voucher** at the concession stands.

DAY 3 – SATURDAY, JUNE 18TH, CONTINUED

Following the game, we'll return to the hotel (estimated arrival by 8:00 p.m.) where you can relax and enjoy the hotel amenities and/or take an evening stroll in chaperone groups.

10:00 p.m. – All choir members need to be in their assigned rooms.

10:30 p.m. – Lights out!

DAY 4 – SUNDAY, JUNE 19TH

*Guided Monuments Tour – National Archives – Franciscan Monastery Concert
Potomac River Dinner Cruise*

Uniform: LCC Chamber Choir T shirt (blue), stone pants/capris/shorts, white tennis shoes; LCC formal concert outfit for afternoon performance packed in garment bag; formal dressy outfit of your choice for dinner cruise

Hotel: Washington Marriott at Metro Center

7:30-8:30 a.m. – Private breakfast buffet at hotel in the Salon 1 conference room located on the second floor – you may eat at any time during these assigned breakfast hours

8:50 a.m. – Gather in hotel lobby – be sure to have your garment bag with your formal concert outfit with you when boarding

9:00 a.m. – Meet our local guides and embark on a **guided monument tour** of the Washington DC area. The tour includes stops at the **Iwo Jima Marine Corps, FDR, Lincoln, Vietnam Veterans, Korean War** and the **Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorials**. We'll see the **Jefferson and Washington Monuments** as well as many others from the bus.

11:45 a.m. – The tour concludes at **Union Station** where you can enjoy lunch on your own in chaperone groups at the Union Station food court.

12:30 p.m. – Board our Imperial Travel buses and travel to the National Archives Museum.

12:50 p.m. – Gather at the entrance for the **National Archives Museum**

1:00 p.m. – Pass through airport-like security and then enjoy a self-guided tour of the National Archives to view the nation's founding documents including the **Declaration of Independence, US Constitution, and Bill of Rights**.

2:30 p.m. – Reconvene as a group and board our buses to travel to the **Franciscan Monastery of the Holy Land in America**.

3:00 p.m. – Arrive at the monastery, change into concert attire and prepare for performance.

4:00 P.M. – LCC CONCERT AT THE FRANCISCAN MONASTERY OF THE HOLY LAND IN AMERICA (main church)

5:15 p.m. – Following the performance, we will return to the hotel to change for the dinner cruise.

6:30 p.m. – Meet in hotel lobby; board buses; travel to boat dock

7:00 p.m. – Board the boat and embark on a **dinner cruise along the Potomac River!** Enjoy a dinner buffet (8:00 p.m.) made from seasonal, local ingredients and listen to live music as you enjoy the amazing views of Washington DC. Dancing and singing is encouraged – and expected!

10:30 p.m. – After the cruise, board buses and return to hotel. Upon our return, all choir members need to be in their assigned rooms with lights out.

DAY 5 – MONDAY, JUNE 20TH

*US Capitol Tour – Jefferson Memorial Concert
Basilica of the Immaculate Conception Tour & Concert*

Uniform: LCC maroon polo; stone PANTS (only), white tennis shoes (NO shorts or capris today due to concerts at the Jefferson Memorial AND Basilica of the Immaculate Conception)

Hotel: Washington Marriott at Metro Center

DAY 5 – MONDAY, JUNE 20TH, CONTINUED

7:00-8:00 a.m. – Private breakfast buffet at hotel in the Salon 1 conference room located on the second floor – you may eat at any time during these assigned breakfast hours (Today is also a federal holiday – observation of Juneteenth.)

8:00 a.m. – Meet in hotel lobby to walk to **Metro Center station**; board Metro orange, blue, or silver line to Capitol South stop (we'll all try to get on the same train); walk as a group to US Capitol Visitor Center (We are unable to take our buses this morning due to driver time off restrictions.)

8:40 a.m. – Arrive at **US Capitol Visitor Center**; go through security.

9:10 a.m. – Group 1 begins guided **US Capitol Tour** (wait in Visitor Center lobby after tour)

9:20 a.m. – Group 2 begins guided **US Capitol Tour**. At the end of the tour, we will meet Group 1 in lobby and get a group picture on the front steps of the Capitol and walk around the outside of the Supreme Court and Library of Congress.

11:30 a.m. – Meet our buses in front of the US Capitol building and travel to the Jefferson Memorial and prepare for our performance

12:00 P.M. – LCC PERFORMS AT THE THOMAS JEFFERSON MEMORIAL At the conclusion of the concert, take a few minutes to visit the memorial and take pictures.

12:45 p.m. – Board the buses which will take us to L'Enfant Plaza where you can have lunch in chaperone groups at the food court or at one of the many food trucks along 7th Street and Maryland.

2:15 p.m. – Meet the buses along L'Enfant Plaza SW and travel to the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception.

3:15 p.m. – Enjoy a guided tour of the basilica.

4:00 P.M. – LCC A CAPPELLA CONCERT IN THE BASILICA OF THE NATIONAL SHRINE OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION (upper church)

4:45 p.m. – Board buses to travel to Alexandria, VA

5:15 p.m. – Arrive in Alexandria's Old Town. Upon arrival, enjoy free time to explore the Old Town in chaperone groups.

6:45 p.m. – Reconvene (exact location TBD upon arrival) and walk together to Chadwick's Restaurant.

7:15 p.m. – LCC farewell dinner at Chadwick's Restaurant in Alexandria's Old Town.

9:00 p.m. (est.) – Following dinner, board our buses and return to the hotel.

10:00 p.m. – All choir members need to be in their assigned rooms.

10:30 p.m. – Lights out!

10:00 a.m. – Arrive at George & Martha Washington's home - **Mount Vernon**. Upon arrival, we will walk together to 12-Acre Field to prepare for our performance.

10:30 P.M. – LCC PERFORMANCE AT 12-ACRE FIELD ON THE GROUNDS OF MOUNT VERNON.

11:00 a.m. – Walk to the food court for **lunch – voucher provided.**

12:00 p.m. – Gather near the entrance of the mansion.

12:15 p.m. – Group 1 takes **guided Mansion Highlights tour.**

12:20 p.m. – Group 2 takes guided Mansion Highlights tour.

1:00 p.m. – Following the mansion tours, return to the Visitors Center, board buses and depart for Cleveland.

DAY 6 – TUESDAY, JUNE 21ST, CONTINUED

4:15 p.m. – 20-minute restroom and snack break at **North Somerset Travel Plaza** on the Pennsylvania Turnpike

7:45 p.m. – Arrive at **Hampton Inn North Olmsted**. Upon arrival, room keys will be distributed to chaperones and the rest of the evening is free to enjoy dinner in chaperone groups at one of the many nearby restaurants (or order in!) with time to relax in the lobby or at the indoor pool with friends – no specific uniform required!

10:00 p.m. – All choir members need to be in their assigned rooms.

10:30 p.m. – Lights out!

DAY 7 – WEDNESDAY, JUNE 22ND

Farewell Concert at Jennings Retirement Community – Great Lakes Science Center – Rock & Roll Hall of Fame –

Farewell Dinner at Texas de Brazil

Uniform: LCC formal concert outfit for morning concert; LCC tie dye T shirt, blue jeans or blue jean capris/shorts, white tennis shoes for afternoon sightseeing and farewell dinner

Hotel: Hampton Inn North Olmsted Cleveland Airport

7:00-9:15 a.m. – Breakfast at hotel – you may eat at any time during these assigned breakfast hours

9:15 a.m. – Gather in lobby; board buses – be sure to have your LCC tie dyed T shirt, blue jeans or blue jean capris/shorts, and white tennis shoes in your garment bag when boarding

9:30 a.m. – Depart for **Jennings Retirement Community** in Garfield Heights, OH

10:00 a.m. – Arrive at Jennings Retirement Community; prepare for concert

10:30 A.M. – LCC FAREWELL CONCERT AT JENNINGS RETIREMENT COMMUNITY; following the concert, enjoy cookies, punch, & fellowship with the residents after which you will have time to change into your LCC informal outfit (tie dyed T shirt & blue jeans/shorts)

12:00 p.m. – Depart Jennings and travel to **downtown Cleveland**

12:30 p.m. – Arrive at **Great Lakes Science Center** in downtown Cleveland. Upon arrival we will pick up our **boxed lunches** at the mezzanine, eat, and visit the exhibits until 2:45 p.m.

2:45 p.m. – Meet in science center lobby; walk together (next door!) to the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame

3:00 p.m. – Tour the **Rock & Roll Hall of Fame** in chaperone groups

5:00 p.m. – Before departing downtown Cleveland, walk to the “Cleveland” sign for a group picture, then board our buses at 5:15 p.m. to travel to Texas de Brazil.

5:45 p.m. – Arrive at Texas de Brazil in Westlake, OH.

6:00 p.m. – **LCC Farewell Dinner at Texas de Brazil**

8:00 p.m. – Board buses and return to hotel

8:20 p.m. – Arrive at hotel with time to relax, swim in the indoor pool, play a game of cards, and enjoy your final night of the tour with your friends.

10:00 p.m. – All choir members need to be in their assigned rooms.

10:30 p.m. – Lights out!

DAY 8 – THURSDAY, JUNE 23RD

Cedar Point – Home to Logansport

Uniform: Souvenir T-shirt Day – If you purchased a shirt along the way as a souvenir, wear it on our trip home with your choice of stone pants or capris/shorts or blue jeans or capris/shorts (whatever is still reasonably clean!). If you didn't buy a souvenir shirt, please plan on wearing any LCC Tour T shirt on the way home with the same choice of pants/capris/shorts as above.

6:30-8:15 a.m. – Breakfast at hotel – you may eat at any time during these assigned breakfast hours

8:15-8:30 a.m. – Turn in room keys to Susan; **turn in vests and ties** (in labeled hangers/bags) in hotel lobby (there will be a suitcase in which to place all vests & ties); load luggage onto buses (one last time!)

DAY 8 – THURSDAY, JUNE 23RD, CONTINUED

8:45 a.m. – Depart for **Cedar Point**

9:45 a.m. – Arrive at **Cedar Point Amusement Park**. After the obligatory group picture, you may enjoy the roller coasters, rides, and attractions of Cedar Point in chaperone groups. Your park ticket also serves as your **meal voucher** – good for one meal at participating park locations. You can also present your park ticket at any participating park restaurant to obtain your **all day drink wristband**. You may want to eat a good breakfast and use your meal voucher later in the day since we won't be making a supper stop. Remember – Cedar Point is CASHLESS, so you will need a debit or credit card to purchase any souvenirs or snacks.

10:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. – Enjoy the roller coasters and rides of Cedar Point in chaperone groups.

4:00 p.m. – Meet at entrance to park; walk to buses

4:15 p.m. – Depart for **Logansport**. Please note that we will NOT make a supper stop on the way home (although we will make a restroom break stop).

8:30 p.m. – Approximate time of arrival at McHale PAC in Logansport. If someone is picking you up or delivering a car to you, please be sure they are there by 8:15 p.m. We would much rather have them wait on us than be waiting on your ride at the end of this trip!

WASHINGTON DC TOUR LOGANSPORT DEPARTURE & ARRIVAL INFORMATION

THURSDAY, JUNE 16TH

6:30 AM – ARRIVE AT LHS – we will meet in front of McHale Performing Arts Center.

Upon arrival at McHale, please leave your luggage either in your car or outside of McHale. Come into the McHale lobby where you will meet with your chaperone. Give any medications and your spending money to your chaperone at this time. Your chaperone will also ask if you have packed your vest and tie and will make sure you have your *sack lunch and drink*. Once the entire chaperone group has arrived and all information above has been checked and received, chaperones should check in with Tim (if you are assigned to his bus) or Susan (if you are assigned to her bus), collect the rest of your luggage from your cars or outside McHale, load your luggage onto the appropriate bus and board your assigned bus. We prefer that you eat breakfast **BEFORE** boarding the bus as we don't want to start off the trip with a bus full of trash.

Note: Cars cannot be parked at the high school for 8 days, so please make arrangements to have someone drop you off or pick up your car.

THURSDAY, JUNE 23RD

8:30 PM – APPROXIMATE TIME OF ARRIVAL AT LHS – in front of McHale Performing Arts Center. If someone is picking you up or delivering a car to you, please be sure they are there by 8:15! We would much rather have them wait on us than be waiting on your ride at the end of this trip! If we are delayed (or if we happen to be running quite a bit ahead of schedule), we will call ahead by cell phone to alert those waiting of the change in arrival time.

ALL CHOIR MEMBERS WILL TURN IN THEIR VEST & TIE AT THE HOTEL ON THE LAST DAY OF THE TOUR!
